YOUR ESTIMATED INDIVIDUAL SETTLEMENT PAYMENT:

You have been identified as a Class Member. Your estimated award is based on your pro-rata percentage of the Net Settlement Amount based on your membership in the Class relative to all Class Members. Your estimated pro-rata share may increase depending on factors such as, but not limited to, the number of Class Members who effectively exclude themselves from the Settlement. The Net Settlement Amount to be distributed to all Class Members who do not opt-out of the Settlement is currently estimated to be \$206,750.00.

YOUR NUMBER OF COMPENSABLE WORKWEEKS:

If you are a Class Member during the PAGA Period – April 26, 2020 through June 13, 2021 – you will also be entitled to a pro rata workweek share of the PAGA Payment for that time period, irrespective of whether or not you request exclusion.

YOU DO NOT NEED TO DO ANYTHING IN ORDER TO RECEIVE MONEY UNDER THE SETTLEMENT.
